



Extension of Closure Timeframe for CCR Surface Impoundments

Unit: Bottom Ash Pond

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 257.102(f)(2), Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Virginia (Dominion Energy) is providing this first demonstration to extend the time necessary to close the Bottom Ash Pond (BAP) at the Chesapeake Energy Center (CEC) in Chesapeake, Virginia. In March 2019, Governor Northam signed legislation (SB 1355) into law requiring the closure by removal of existing coal combustion residual (CCR) at CEC, including the BAP and other CCR surface impoundments at three other Dominion Energy facilities. The law requires that the CCR be removed from these units for disposal to a lined landfill or for beneficiation by July 2034.

Dominion Energy is in the process of obtaining the necessary permits from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and other agencies for the closure of the BAP. Once permitting is complete, removal of CCR from the BAP will commence. Therefore, this first demonstration documents the need to extend the timeframe for closure of the BAP for two years as allowed under Section 257.102(f)(2) of the CCR rule.
