Nimbus Substation and 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to updating you about projects in your community. You are receiving this postcard because construction is scheduled to begin this summer on our new Nimbus Substation in eastern Loudoun County, Virginia. This project will improve electric reliability for area customers.

PHASE 1: SUMMER 2023 – DECEMBER 2024

- July 2023 — Nimbus Substation site preparation, including building a retaining wall for soil stability
- 2024 — Build new double circuit 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line to connect an existing transmission line to Nimbus Substation along the south side of Waxpool Road

PHASE 2: 2025

- Build new single circuit 230 kV electric transmission line to connect existing Farmwell Substation to new Nimbus Substation

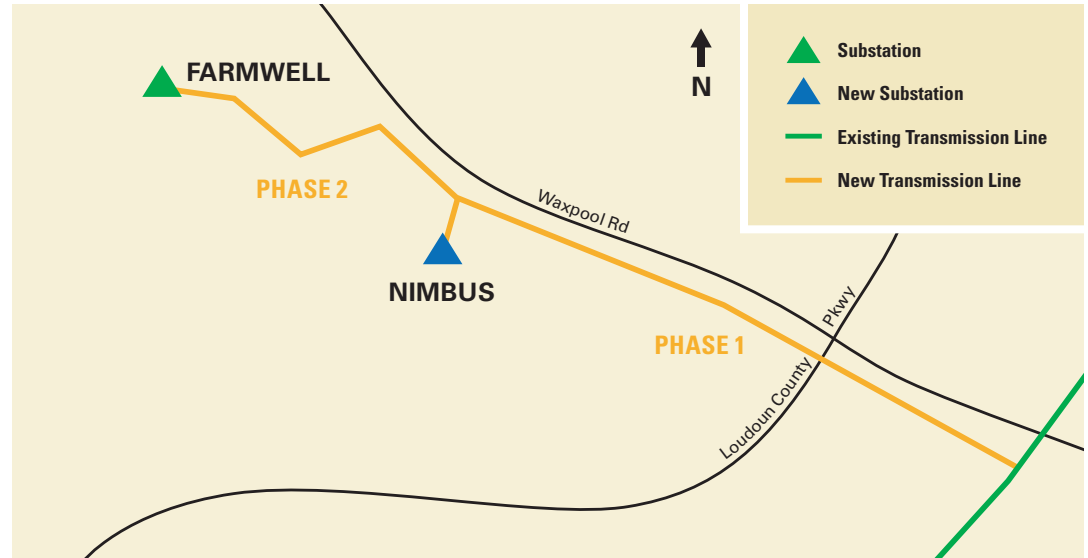
All work is scheduled to occur during daytime. Temporary traffic impacts on Loudoun County Parkway will be posted in advance in accordance with Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) permits.

During construction, sidewalks may be closed at times. Please observe pedestrian signage for your safety.

We will update you on progress. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we complete this important reliability project.
