Craigsville - Goshen 115 kV Partial Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable, and affordable electricity to our neighbors. You are receiving this postcard because we are currently preparing to rebuild a portion of the single-circuit 115 kV transmission line between our Craigsville Substation in Augusta County, Virginia, and our Goshen Substation in Rockbridge County, Virginia.

After nearly 100 years of service, the current line has reached its end of service life and needs to be replaced. We plan to rebuild the transmission lines and structures in this 11-mile corridor to meet current reliability standards.

In the coming weeks, our crews and contractors will be in the right of way corridor surveying the conditions of potential access roads. During this time, survey work will also be conducted for proposed roads outside the right of way corridor. You can expect to see crews on foot or in vehicles accessing the right of way, which may include the use of access roads outside the right of way. Construction will begin after all necessary permits and approvals are received. Currently, we anticipate construction to begin in July 2023. We will keep you updated as construction activities progress.
