Woodbridge-Occoquan 230 kV Electric Transmission Reconductor Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable, and affordable electricity to our neighbors. You are receiving this postcard because we are preparing to replace conductor wire on existing electric transmission structures between our Woodbridge and Occoquan substations in Prince William and Fairfax counties, Virginia.

After more than four decades of service, the conductor wire that runs for 4.6 miles between the substations is at the end of its service life and needs to be replaced to maintain electric reliability for our customers. For this project, we are only replacing the conductor wire, not the existing transmission structures.

In the coming weeks, you will see Dominion Energy crews and contractors in and near the right of way corridor completing surveying activities as we prepare for construction. You can expect to see personnel in vehicles or on foot accessing the right of way, which may include use of access roads outside the right of way.

Construction is scheduled to begin in summer 2021 and be completed by late 2021. During construction, wire pulling across roads will require temporary lane closures and short stoppages for safety of the public and our crews. After construction is complete, crews will remove temporary access roads and restore the area to its previous condition. Restoration will last into spring 2022. We will continue to keep you updated as activities progress.

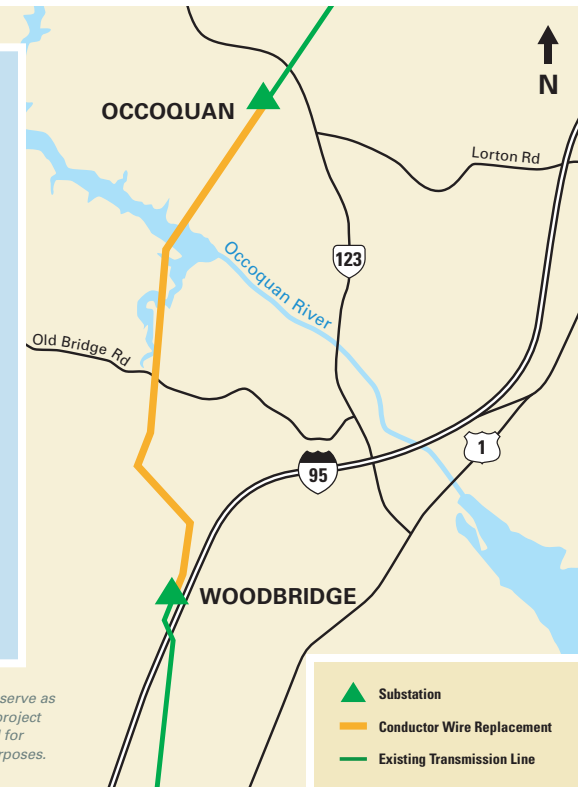
