## Manage your bills with a payment plan

Refer to the **“Payment Programs for Eligible Customers”** section of your bill or visit [DominionEnergy.com/winter-assistance](https://www.dominionenergy.com/winter-assistance) for details and to determine eligibility, including the Percentage of Income Payment Program (PIPP Plus).

## Special Reconnect Order

Maintain or restore service for the winter.

Residential customers may avoid a shut-off or restore gas service once during the heating season from **October 17, 2022, until April 14, 2023.**

### Maintain or have service restored by paying the lesser of:

- The entire past-due balance on your gas bill.
- The past-due payments if you are on a special payment plan.
- \$175, plus \$33 reconnection fee applied to the first bill.

## Medical Certification

Medical Certification delays a loss of, or restores, gas service within 21 calendar days when a loss of service would be especially dangerous to the health of a permanent member of a household. Available year-round. For details, refer to the **“Billing, Service Inquiries or Concerns”** section of your bill.

## Energy Assistance & Weatherization for Income-Eligible Households

To qualify for the following program, your gross household income from all sources must be at or below the income guidelines listed on the chart below:

- For help to avoid a shut off or to restore service, income-eligible households can apply for the **Winter Crisis Program (WCP)**, which provides a one-time payment.
- **Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)** provides a one-time credit to your heating bill.

- **Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP)** provides federally funded grants for weatherization repairs of income-eligible households.

For households with more than eight (8) members: **Add \$8,260 for 175%** • **Add \$9,440 for 200%**, per each additional member.
