

The following plan has been approved by Huntley Meadows Park Authority and is scheduled to begin in August 2018. Please note our schedule is subject to change based on weather conditions; however, we will continue our efforts until the corridor is returned to its preexisting condition. Once this is achieved, the ponding should be drastically reduced, but could resurface in the event of future storms, which is typical in wetland habitats.

- Crews will identify any remaining remnants of wooden matting, metal signs and posts, and dispose off-site if found.
- To restore compacted areas where excessive ponding water has been present, we will utilize a low-impact amphibious Marsh Master. This machine is equipped with rake attachments and will traverse the previously matted road in order to lift, aerate and break up compacted soil in preparation of seeding.
- Handwork will be completed to pull the road edges back into its original position. Hand seeding will follow using wetland seed mix approved by the park authority.
- RES, a third-party environmental company, will complete weekly inspections on growth progress.
