RE: Belvoir – Gum Springs Rebuild Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing safe and reliable power to our neighbors. You are receiving this letter because your property is located near an existing transmission line corridor. It has become necessary for us to rebuild this aging infrastructure to ensure continued reliable electric service.

Over the next few months, you will see our employees and authorized contractors accessing properties along the existing right of way corridor to begin pre-construction activities.

Pre-construction Activities: Beginning Mid-July 2017

Some activities being performed include:

- Surveying/marketing boundaries of the right of way
- Delineating wetlands
- Placing stakes at the locations of the new transmission structures
- Installing access roads, using gravel or timber matting, at construction entrances to allow equipment to safely ingress and egress various locations along the right of way.
- Frye Road and Kidd Street will be the main project access roads. Additional roads may be used for minor equipment and personnel access.

No danger trees will be cleared for this project. (Danger trees are located outside of the right of way, but are tall enough to potentially impact the transmission lines.) We will continue to maintain safe clearances in the right of way.

Construction Activities: Fall 2017 – Spring 2018

After these pre-construction activities are complete, we will begin the construction process. We will build new structures and remove the old ones within the right of way corridor. Once the new structures have been constructed, rehab work will begin and may continue through summer 2018.

Your electric service will NOT be interrupted as a result of this project. We are committed to working safely and courteously in your neighborhood, and we will restore the right of way when our work is complete.
