


# DOMINION PROJECT TO REBUILD AGING LINE IN ALEXANDRIA (FAIRFAX COUNTY)

Dominion Virginia Power proposes improvements to infrastructure to strengthen service reliability.

Dominion is committed to providing safe and reliable power to customers. In order to comply with current, federally-mandated operating standards, Dominion is planning to replace an aging 230 kilovolt (kV) transmission line along a 2.6-mile stretch of existing right of way between its Belvoir and Gum Springs Substations in Fairfax.

This rebuild project will include replacing the existing structures and wires, which have been in place since the 1960's and have reached the end of their functional life, with new poles capable of enhancing reliability to area residents and businesses.



The change in structure height and design will allow for fewer poles than are currently in use and less land disturbance once in place. New structures in some areas will drop in height.

This design allows the new structures to be placed along the centerline of the corridor – preserving the existing tree buffer along the easement line and creating additional space for today's clearance requirements.

## Dominion's improved line project will:

- comply with mandatory reliability standards,
- conform to current safety criteria, and
- take advantage of the existing corridor.

## Target Schedule

<b>Summer 2015</b>	Outreach to State and Local officials
<b>Fall 2015</b>	Public outreach, letters, website, open house
<b>December 2015</b>	Submit application with the State Corporation Commission for consideration
<b>Summer 2016</b>	Construction scheduled to begin, pending SCC approval, applicable permits
<b>Winter 2016</b>	Target date to energize transmission line
