FUDGE HOLLOW-LOW MOOR 138 KV ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION PARTIAL REBUILD PROJECT

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide the most safe and reliable electric service to our neighbors.

PROJECT: We have an existing 138 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line that runs between our Fudge Hollow and Low Moor substations in Allegheny County. A portion of this line passes through the city of Covington, Virginia, along the south side of Interstate 64. The line — originally constructed in the early 1920s — is old and needs to be replaced to maintain consistency with current electrical and safety standards. This project will maintain reliability for 9,700 customers of Dominion Energy and BARC and Craig-Botetourt electric cooperatives. The project includes partially replacing about 5.3 miles of existing lattice-type structures. We do not anticipate a need for additional right of way.
