Anne E. Bomar is senior vice president–Gas Transmission Commercial Services, Gas Infrastructure Group.

She oversees the commercial aspects of Dominion Energy’s natural gas pipeline businesses: marketing, business development and transportation services. Bomar also represents Dominion Energy on the Board of Managers for Atlantic Coast Pipeline.

Bomar joined Consolidated Natural Gas (CNG) in 1985, and worked in Corporate Planning, Rates and Gas Procurement prior to joining the company’s law department. As an attorney with CNG, Bomar practiced in Washington for nine years.



She served as director–Rates & Certificates from May 1999 until CNG’s merger with Dominion in 2000, when she became managing counsel–Gas Transportation & Storage. In January 2003, she was named managing director–Transmission Rates & Regulation, and became vice president–Federal Regulation in February 2006.

Bomar was named vice president and general manager–Dominion East Ohio in July 2009. She became senior vice president and general manager in December 2009, leading Dominion’s Ohio and West Virginia gas distribution operations for four years. In April 2013 Bomar served as senior vice president–Strategy and in 2018 was appointed senior vice president – Pipeline Services and Optimization. She assumed her current post in February 2019.

Bomar earned a bachelor’s degree in economics from Cornell University. She holds a law degree from the Marshall-Wythe School of Law at the College of William and Mary, where she serves as Vice President of the Board of Directors for the Law School Alumni Association. She is also an Associate Member of the Virginia State Bar and a member of ‘In Counsel with Women,’ in Cleveland.
