Diane Leopold is executive vice president and president and chief executive officer of the Gas Infrastructure Group.

Her business unit is responsible for 2.3 million natural gas customer accounts in five states; 15,000 miles of natural gas transmission, storage and gathering pipeline and nearly 51,000 miles of gas distribution pipeline; more than 1 trillion cubic feet of natural gas storage; and 1.3 million retail energy and related services customer accounts in 13 states.

Recent positions include senior vice president–Business Development & Generation Construction, senior vice president–Dominion Transmission, and president of the company’s gas business unit. She became president and CEO of the gas business unit in January 2017 and was promoted to executive vice president in May 2017.

Leopold is a member of the board of trustees of Virginia Union University and recently served as president of the board of trustees of the Virginia Commonwealth University Foundation. She is past chair of the Interstate Natural Gas Association of America, where she currently serves on its board, and is also a member of the board and executive committee of the American Gas Association. She also is a member of the board of directors of Markel Corporation.

She graduated from the University of Sussex in the United Kingdom in 1989 with a bachelor’s degree in mechanical and electrical engineering. She received a master’s degree in electrical engineering (energy conversion, power and transmission) in 1993 from George Washington University and an MBA in 1998 from Virginia Commonwealth University.
