Paul E. Ruppert is president of Gas Transmission, Gas Infrastructure Group.

He oversees all FERC-regulated businesses and projects in the company's Gas Infrastructure Group, including Dominion Energy Transmission, Dominion Energy Carolina Gas, Dominion Energy Cove Point, Dominion Energy Questar Pipeline, and the Atlantic Coast Pipeline.

Employed by Dominion since 1987, Ruppert started as a field worker in Weston, W.Va., and became an engineer in Production in Clarksburg, W.Va., later that year. He transferred to Operations in 1990 and became division engineer in 1991. He became manager-Field Support in 1995 and later held various supervisory positions within Engineering.

He became director-Engineering Services in 2000 and vice president—Pipeline Engineering & Plant Operations for Dominion Transmission in 2003. He was named senior vice president—Dominion Transmission in June 2009, and senior vice president—Business Development & Generation Construction in April 2012. He was named president—Dominion Midstream Operations in January 2016 and assumed his current post in August 2017.

Ruppert is a member of the boards of directors of the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education and the Dominion Energy Credit Union.

A graduate of West Virginia University with a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering, he also earned his master's degree in business administration from West Virginia Wesleyan College. He is a registered professional engineer.
