

DOMINION ENERGY SOLUTIONS DISCLOSURE STATEMENT PAPUC LICENSE NO. A-110008

This offer is for Residential Customers of Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec").

Background on Dominion and Electric Choice

This is your agreement for electricity generation supplied by Dominion Energy Solutions ("Dominion"). Please keep a copy for your records. Dominion is licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer and supply electricity in Pennsylvania. Our license number is A-110008. Dominion supplies the electricity to your electric distribution company based on how much you consume. Penelec, your electric distribution company, will then distribute (deliver) the electricity to you. If you have any questions regarding distribution, please contact them directly at 1-800-545-7741. Dominion sets its generation prices and charges that you pay. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission regulates electric distribution services provided by Penelec. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services. Dominion's charges for electricity (generation and transmission) will appear on your electric distribution company's bill in a separate section.

Key Definitions

Generation Charge – Charge for the production of electricity.

Transmission Charge – Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generating facility to the distribution lines of the electric distribution company.

Basic Charges

Dominion's Generation and Transmission Charge

You will pay Dominion a total combined Generation and Transmission Charge of \$0.0779 per kWh through your December 2015 meter read date ("the Firm Price Period"). The price to be charged after the Firm Price Period will be determined in accordance with Section 1. of this Disclosure Statement. Your price will include applicable Pennsylvania gross receipts tax but does not include applicable Pennsylvania sales tax. Dominion is required to collect sales tax unless you submit a sales tax exemption form. If you are exempt from sales tax, you must submit a sales tax exemption form to Dominion before any exemption can be processed.

Service Provisions

1. Term: The Firm Price period will begin on the next scheduled meter read date after your enrollment has been accepted by your local distribution utility and will continue through your December 2015 meter read date. Subject to the notice to be given to you by Dominion as set forth in the second paragraph of this Section 1., after the Firm Price Period this agreement shall automatically continue on a month-to-month basis subject to cancellation at any time by either party without penalty. The price you will pay after the Firm Price Period shall be adjustable at Dominion's reasonable discretion based upon then-applicable market price related factors which include, but are not limited to, costs for electricity, transmission, ancillary and capacity costs, plus Dominion's costs, expenses and margins.

If you have a fixed term agreement with us and it is approaching the expiration date or whenever we propose to change our terms of service in any type of agreement, you will receive written notification from us in each of our last two bills for supply charges or in corresponding separate mailings that precede either the expiration date or the effective date of the proposed changes. We will explain your options to you in these two advance notifications.

2. Penalties, Fees, Exceptions: Dominion may charge a late payment fee of 1.5% monthly on any past due balances.

3. Cancellation/Relocation Provisions: You may cancel this agreement anytime without penalty. Dominion may cancel this agreement without penalty at any time after the expiration of the Firm Price Period upon 30 days written notice.

4. Billing: You will receive a single bill from Penelec that will contain Penelec's charges and Dominion's charges. Payments will be due according to Penelec's billing schedule. If you fail to pay your bill in a timely manner we may cancel this agreement upon 10 days written notice.

5. Right of Rescission: You have the right to cancel this agreement at any time before midnight of the tenth business day after signing up for this offer.

6. Dispute Procedures: Contact Dominion at 1-800-264-4754 or by mail at P.O. Box 298, Pittsburgh, PA 15230 with any questions concerning our terms of service. You may call the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at 1-800-782-1110 or write to them at the Bureau of Consumer Service, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265 if you are not satisfied after discussing your terms with Dominion.

7. Limits on Warranties and Damages: You understand and agree that there are no warranties, either express or implied, associated with this offer or the electricity service sold hereunder. Dominion will bear no liability to you or any third party for consequential, punitive, incidental, special or other indirect damages.

8. Governmental Actions: If action is taken by federal or state governmental authorities which significantly changes the way Dominion does business with you, Dominion may change its price to you, or terminate this agreement upon 30 days written notice, after which you can return to your local utility to provide your electricity needs or enroll with another supplier.

9. Assignment: Dominion may assign this agreement to an affiliate or third party, in whole or in part. Dominion will provide you a 30 day notice of any assignment.

10. Eligibility: Only Penelec residential accounts are eligible. No other rate codes will be accepted. Dominion does not offer net metering to customer-generators taking service from Dominion.
